Dear Parents/Guardians of École Lord Tweedsmuir Students:

Although we are learning remotely and things are not the same, we would still like to have our *Lord Tweedsmuir Has Talent*, talent show! We were in the process of organizing a real-life talent show before Spring Break, and we were going to hold auditions at the end of April. We thought it would still be fun to have our talent show even though it will have to be online! It will be presented in your child's online Google classroom or MS Teams classroom which is only accessible to the students of Lord Tweedsmuir who must login first to view the presentations. If your child would like to perform in the virtual talent show, here is the criteria:

CHOICE OF FORMAT OPTIONS

1) A video of your child performing (eg. via You Tube, Adobe Spark, Shadow Puppet EDU).

Here is a tutorial on using [Adobe Spark](#). Please note that sending a link to the video is preferred over sending a video file.

2) An audio file of your child performing, along with a photo for a visual.

3) An audio file of your child performing, along with visuals other than your child's photo (if you do not want your child's photo in the presentation).

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must showcase a talent the student has such as singing, playing an instrument, dancing, doing a magic trick, juggling, etc.
- Performance pieces should be no longer than 3 minutes-hopefully they will be shorter.
- Performance pieces must be very well prepared and practiced (as they must be for a live performance).
- Performers should introduce themselves before they perform with their first name, teacher's name(s) and a title for their presentation (eg. I am Debbie from Mrs. Richter's class and I will be doing a dance to *Everybody Dance Now*).
- You may have more than one of your children in the performance.

If your child(ren) are interested in participating, please complete the attached [consent form](#) and **submit by May 20, 2020**. Your video or audio file should be submitted by **May 27, 2020**.

Please email Ms. Ramen at dramen@sd40.bc.ca with your video link. An email will be sent acknowledging receipt of your file. If you do not receive a response within 24 hours, please contact Ms. Ramen at the school.

The virtual talent show will be presented on **June 1st, 2020** in each of your Google Classroom or MS Teams Classroom and will remain up for viewing until **June 22nd, 2020**. All videos will be removed from Google Classrooms or MS Teams Classrooms on **June 23rd, 2020**.
