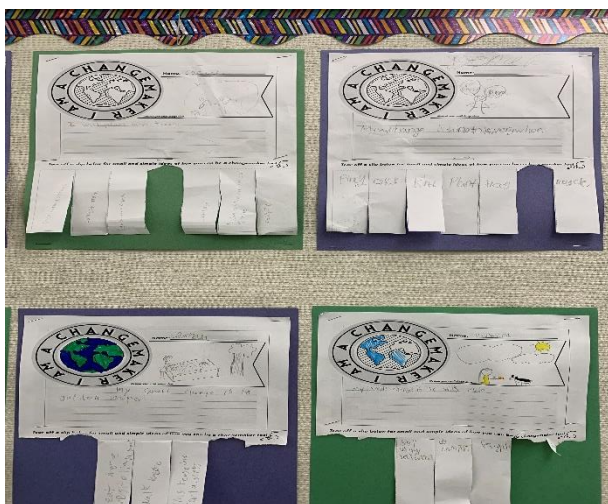
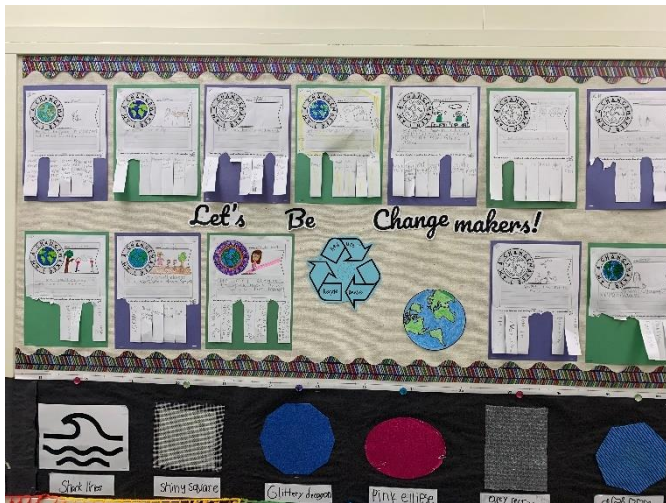


WEATHER CHANGES
