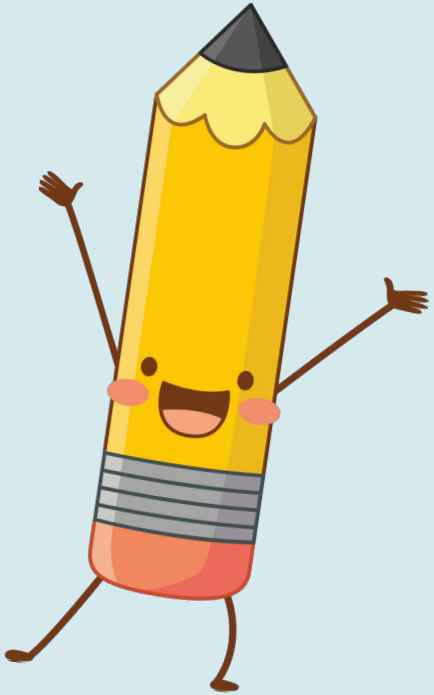
3. To promote co-operation between the home and the school in providing for the education of children.
