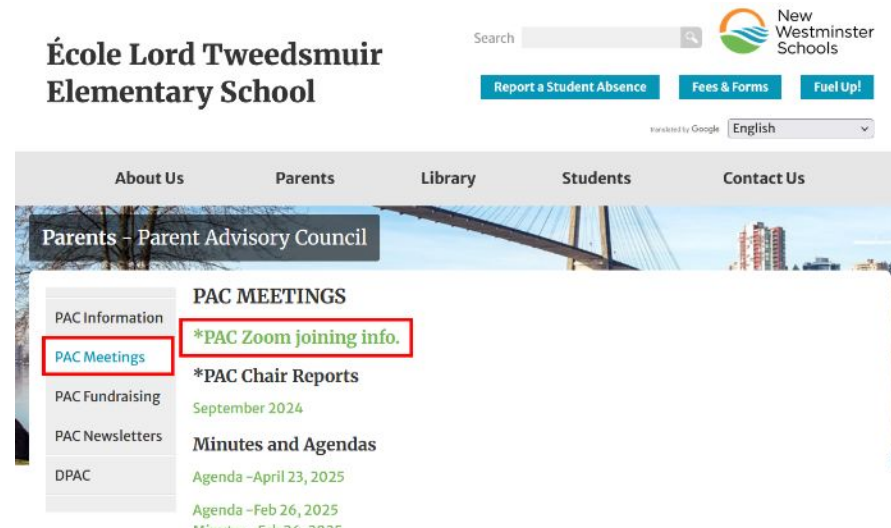

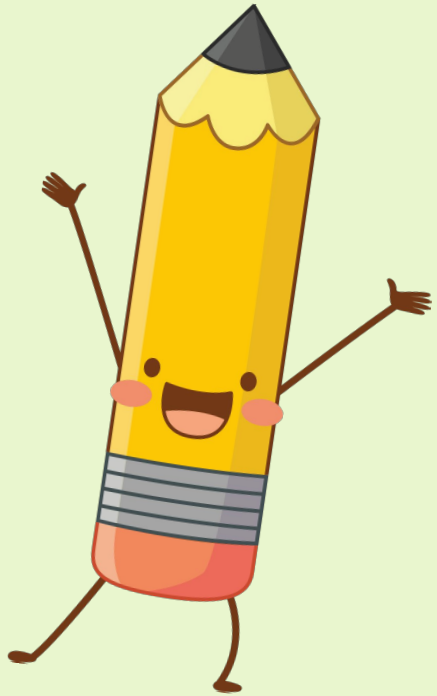
General PAC Info

 - ▶ Regularly review and plan logistics like setup, impact of weather, and type materials
