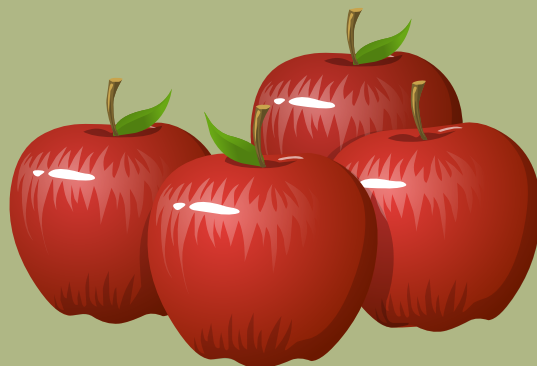
Meet the PAC Executive
